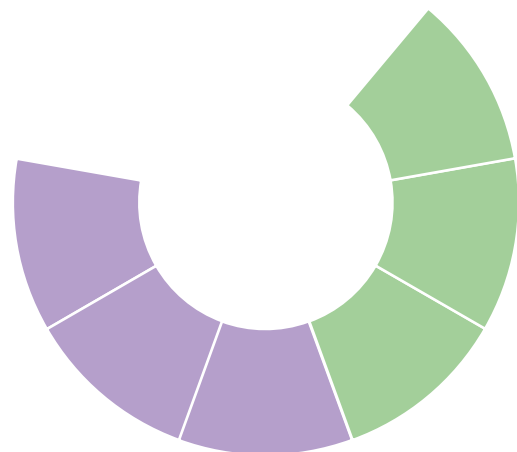


The UCL Ways of Working for professional services supports colleagues to be successful and happy at UCL through sharing expectations around how we work.
