PURPOSE: The purpose of performing repeat and near-repeat victimisation analysis is to identify those people, properties and places that are at a disproportionate risk of victimisation. Pure *repeat victims* (RVs) are targets that are victimised multiple times (e.g., a domestic violence victim or a school that is burgled three times in one year). *Near-repeat victims* (NRV) are targets that are situated in close proximity to an original target, and that get victimised soon after the original target. Previous (near) victimisa
