Sarah Holborn Bursary for students entering years 2,4,5,6..... 11

Established in 2004 by a donation of £50,000 from Mrs Hilda Robinson as an expression of her gratitude for services rendered to her over a number of years by Professor Albert Singer, Professor of Gynaecology at The Hospital.

- o The income from this fund to be applied for the alleviation of financial hardship amongst students in-Years 4 & 6 of the MBBS programme at the discretion of Divisional Tutor for the MBBS.
- o Students experiencing financial hardship are to be invited to meet with the UCLMS Divisional Tutor to discuss their financial situation and to provide such appropriate supporting documentary evidence as s/he may require.
- o Approximately £5,000 to fund multiple awards

#### Pranker Jones Memorial Fund bursaries for overseas students

The Pranker Jones Memorial Prize and bursaries were founded in 1983 by the subscribers to the Pranker Jones Memorial Fund, in memory of Nicola Pranker (a former student of University College Hospital School of Medicine, 1978), her brother, Richard Pranker, and Alison Jones (a former student of the Slade School of Art, 1976) who were murdered in Zimbabwe in 1982. - o The aim of this fund in 2016 was to help all students with a focus on AccessUCL Under-represented backgrounds and those who those who contribute to their community in some way. Awarded in amount depending on need and could be for emergency situations, to help achieve a certain education related goal, or to help those financially impacted by the coronavirus pandemic.

## Ferriere Scholarship for students entering years 4, 5, 6

Founded at UCH School of Medicine in 1930

- o A scholarship known as the Ferriere Scholarship may be awarded in each session.
- o The Scholarship is awarded by UCL Medical School.
- o The award is made to a candidate of high academic promise who has completed Year 1 and Year 2 of the MBBS programme at UCL and who without financial assistance would be unable to complete the medical course.
- o The value of the Scholarships are to be determined, within the annual income generated by the fund, by the UCLMS Bursaries Committee chaired by the Divisional Tutor or representative.
- o Candidates must submit written notice of their intention to compete for the Scholarship to the UCLMS Bursaries Committee via the Annual Bursarie (i)3.4 .5 (tooe2).4 (e)3 (t)e (c1.6 (e)3 7 (nc)5.8 m)4.6 (n.4 (o)2..7

## Dr Norman Munro Medical Scholarship for students entering years 4, 5, 6

Founded in 2014 in memory of Dr Norman Munro.

1. Gift amount and purpose:

A gift in memory of Dr Thomas Norman Munro, who graduated from UCH Medical School in 1958, was bestowed for the purpose of student support in the Medical School. Dr Norman Munro bequeathed all of his remaining estate on the death of his widow to UCL Medical School to support students in financial hardship to complete their studies as

- o May be awarded for up to 3 years.
- o Age limit: 27 years on 31st July.
- o Awarded to a candidate who is now or will be in the first year of study for the London MBBS degree and who does not hold any other scholarship awarded by the School.
- o Candidates must produce certificates of sound health.
- o Awards extended to men and women in 2014 in line with equalities advice.
- o Approximately £150.

#### Isabel Pulteney Scholarship for Women for students entering year 2

- o May be awarded for up to 4 years.
- o To be awarded to a student who, by the October following the award, will have completed her first year as a mission student and begun the preclinical course at the School.
- o Awards extended to men and women in 2014 in line with equalities advice
- o Approximately £350

#### John Byron Bursary for Women for students entering years 2,4,5,6

- o Candidates must be in need of financial assistance.
- o 2014: awards extended to men and women in line with equalities advice

- o Successful candidates must continue to read for the medical examination and, should she cease her studies, the amount received shall be returnable to the Trustees.
- o Awards extended to men and women in 2014 in line with equalities advice.

### Peter Costin Memorial Scholarship for students entering years 5,6

Established in 2013

1. Gift amount and purpose:

A gift in memory of Peter Costin has been bestowed through the Royal Free Charity to be used for the alleviation of financial hardship amongst students in the UCL Medical School who have completed a clinical placement at the Royal Free Hospital.

2. Use of gift:

The bursary will provide much needed funds for UCL students in the final 2 years of their MBBS degree programme who are financially penalised by NHS bursaries failing to cover the costs of increased tuition fees. The bursary will be named the Peter Costin Memorial Scholarship.

3. Award Regulations:

The bursary will be awarded once per annum to deserving students in the Medical School. Applicants will be asked to submit a written application.

## Fitzmaurice Family Scholarship

Established in January 2024 by the Fitzmaurice Family as part of a donation to UCL Medical School to support two undergraduate scholarships, a bursary and general medical student hardship funds.

- o Two Fitzmaurice Family Scholarships be awarded to undergraduate medical students entering the MBBS programme: the first in October 2024 and the second in October 2025.
- o Awards are made on the basis of financial need and academic achievement.
